Governor Wolf Plans to Lift School Mask Mandate

Earlier this week, <u>Governor Wolf announced</u> that the Pennsylvania Department of Health will be lifting the statewide school mask mandate on January 17, 2022. The PA AAP has communicated our explicit disapproval of this decision, citing the lack of evidence to support such a move. See our press release <u>here</u>. Given Governor Wolf's recent announcement, the Chapter will continue to advocate that schools enforce the mandate and promote the efficacy of a multi-layer mitigation strategy. We hope that, in continuing to partner with the Department of Health, our stance will be more widely received.

PA & Federal Updates

- There were 33,394 new cases in Pennsylvania since our last update on 11/5 bringing the total case count to 1,618,870 (includes confirmed and probable cases) in all 67 counties in PA. Statewide percent positivity for the week of Oct. 29 Nov. 4 stood at 9.3%--an increase from 8.8%, recorded Oct. 22 28. View a breakdown of cases by region, county, gender, ethnicity, etc. here.
- This week, the Commonwealth Court issued a ruling voiding Acting Secretary of Health Alison Beam's mask order. The state has filed an appeal, triggering a stay of the Court's ruling and so sustaining the mask mandate. Read more here.

- As of November 4, more than 6.5 million children have tested positive for COVID-19 since
 the onset of the pandemic, representing 16.7% of all cases in states reporting cases by
 age. Last week, over 107,000 new child COVID-19 cases were reported, accounting for
